Photography Contest Rules

1. Image must be taken by participant named on entry form.
2. Image must be taken within the last year.
3. Image may be in black and white or color, digital or film.
4. Image must be an 8x10 print and submitted no later than 7 days prior to Herald Day to ensure proper display requirements of entries. Framing is not required and the prints will be displayed in plastic protective covers.
5. Images may have MINOR adjustments but a naturally occurring composition. (Composite images are not eligible and neither are overly processed images.)
6. Historic Herald division is for images that best display historical Herald life. This category must only have images taken within Herald town limits.
7. All participants must read and sign the release on entry form.
8. Please make arrangements to pick up your print after Herald Day and know that images may be kept longer on display if awarded and also may be used in a calendar to raise funds for Herald Community Club Non-Profit Organization.
